
The Nebraska Cultural Endowment agrees to adhere to the restrictions detailed in the Rules and Regulations for LB799, Nebraska Administrative Code Chapter 82, Sections 330, 331, 332, 333. The distribution of the funds shall be governed by articles of incorporation, by-laws, and an operating agreement of the following three entities: Nebraska Arts Council, Nebraska Humanities Council, and the Nebraska Cultural Endowment. The ultimate use of disbursements from this amount shall be in a ratio of seventy percent (70%) to projects, endowments, or programs designated by the Nebraska Arts Council and thirty percent (30%) to projects, endowments, or programs designated by the Nebraska Humanities Council. Payment amount may include interest earned on the account.

Payment Amounts:

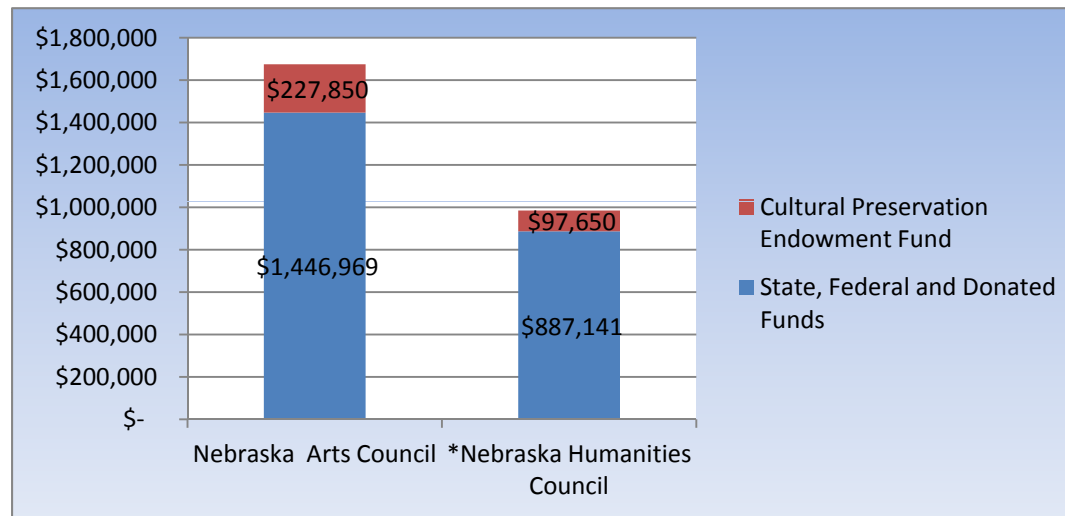
