81-3132: Update on ACCESSNebraska

Staffing

The Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) has evaluated the need for staff in local offices across the state. The data used to determine staffing locations was number of persons receiving Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), formerly known as food stamps.

Attached is a map showing the number of SNAP recipients per county as well as the number of staff and the counties where they are located. (Attachment A)

In addition to the attached data, Economic Assistance Administrators were asked to provide information specific to their geographic areas. Their input was also considered when determining staffing needs. The same data and information will be used when filling additional positions for LB 825.

As of September 1, 2012, the following staff have been retained, hired or are in the process of being hired.

DHHS retained 22.5 Social Service Workers in the Central and Western Service Areas. These staff were scheduled for layoff in July 2012. Experienced and bilingual staff were retained in the following offices:

- o Hastings 5
- o Broken Bow 3
- o Kearney 3
- o Imperial- 1.5
- McCook 2

- o **Ord 1**

DHHS added six (6) Social Service Workers in the Eastern Service Area. Some staff were recalled from the employee reemployment pool while others are transferring from other offices. They are or will be in the following offices:

- o 3737 Lake St., Omaha 2
- 5211 South 31st St., Omaha 2
- 1261 Golden Gate Dr., Papillion 2

DHHS is in the process of hiring the following positions:

- Pender: 2 Social Service Workers
- o Southeast Service Area (Lincoln area): 1 Community Support Specialist
- Fremont Customer Service Center: 2 Social Service Workers will assist walk-ins to the Fremont Customer Service Center as well as travel to itinerate offices in Wahoo and Blair.

It is anticipated that additional staff will be hired by November 1, 2012 to help meet the needs of the local offices. Additional hiring will occur based on available dollars and the needs as identified by SNAP participation numbers and information received from the Service Areas.

Customer Service

DHHS has specialized staff assigned to Spousal Impoverishment and Refugee applications until the application process of the case is complete. This helps to ensure that these complicated cases are properly processed.

DHHS allows every client to ask for an in-person interview. Currently, 99% of interviews are done by telephone.

DHHS assists individuals who walk into a local office where Economic Assistance staff are located. Staff can assist with applying on-line, completing a paper application, answer general questions and accept and scan client paperwork.

DHHS has an email address where questions can be directed. They are responded to by an employee who is well trained in that program area. That email address is <u>dhhs.ACCESSNebraskaquestions@nebraska.gov</u>.

DHHS has kiosks available for client use where clients can apply for services, check case status and provide updates. (Attachment B)

Community Partners

DHHS has over six hundred community partners who provide various levels of service. The level of service is determined by the community partner. The Community Partners can participate in a community partner workgroup. DHHS convenes a monthly community partner phone call to discuss concerns and ideas. The Community Support Specialists participate in the monthly phone call.

DHHS currently has eight (8) Community Support Specialists and are in the process of hiring a ninth who will be located in the Southeast Service Area. The Community Support Specialists work closely with the Community Partners to offer support to them.

The Community Partners are not paid for their services nor are they in a contractual agreement.


