Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB1099, introduced by Senator Bostelman, directs DOE to create a Hydrogen Hub Industry work group for the purpose of developing and drafting competitive proposals which may be submitted to the United States Department of Energy to seek selection as one of four regional clean hydrogen hubs authorized under the federal infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act.

Sec. 1 Requires Department of Economic Development to create the Nebraska Hydrogen Hub Industry Work Group.

Identifies business and professional areas from various businesses and professions that shall be appointed to be members of the group.

Sec. 2 Emergency clause.

Explanation of amendments:

AM 1985 is a white copy amendment that makes the following changes to the bill as originally introduced:

Strikes the operative date of the Act.	
Substitutes permissive for mandatory directions regarding formation of	working group.
Changes who appoints the working group from the Director of DOE to the Governor to comply with the Constitution Strikes the General Fund Appropriation.
