**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB1244 would amend Sec. 29-3001 to toll the statute of limitations for a post-conviction relief action if a case has been appealed from the Nebraska Supreme Court to the United States Supreme Court. The one year statute of limitations would be tolled until the U.S. Supreme Court affirms the conviction or denies the writ of certiorari.
