Summary of purpose and/or changes:

A REVISED VERSION OF LB714 WAS AMENDED INTO LB750. REFER TO THE LB750 COMMITTEE STATEMENT FOR FURTHER INFOMRATION.

LB714 would propose to amend section 60-4,115- the distribution of fees collected for the issuance of operator's licenses and state identification cards.

Currently the \$24 fee charged for the issuance of an operator's license or state identification card that is valid for 5 years is distributed as follows:

County General Fund \$3.50 DMV Cash Fund \$10.25

State General Fund \$10.25

LB 714 revises the distribution of the \$24 fee as follows:

County General Fund \$3.50

DMV Cash Fund \$13.25

State General Fund \$7.25

The Committee considered and adopted an amendment which adds section 60-1515 to the bill and creates a new subsection (3) which provides that \$3 from each Class O operator's license and State Identification Card that is issued and valid for 5 years shall be deposited to the DMV Cash Fund and shall utilized to open and operate an additional operator's license service center.
