Summary:

Current law provides a tuition assistance benefit for members of the Nebraska National Guard. This tuition assistance benefit is available for a variety of state-supported higher education options, and includes 100 percent of resident tuition for associate and baccalaureate degree programs, and 50 percent of resident tuition for graduate or professional degree programs.

Members are no longer eligible for the tuition assistance benefit once ten years have elapsed since their initial membership. This bill would eliminate that ten-year eligibility limitation.
