- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated \$2,000,000 from the General

- 3 carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 1024, One Hundred Seventh
- 4 Legislature, Second Session, 2022.
- 5 <u>No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems</u>
- 6 <u>for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this</u>
- 7 section.
- 8 The unexpended balance of General Funds appropriated to this program
- 9 in this section for FY2021-22 is hereby reappropriated for FY2022-23.
- Sec. 2. There is hereby appropriated \$10,000,000 from the General
- 11 Fund for FY2022-23 to the Department of Economic Development, for Program
- 12 <u>611, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 1024, One</u>
- 13 <u>Hundred Seventh Legislature, Second Session, 2022.</u>
- 14 No expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems
- 15 for state employees shall be made from funds appropriated in this
- 16 section.
- 17 It is the intent of the Legislature that the unexpended balance of
- 18 General Funds appropriated to this program in this section for FY2022-23
- 19 <u>be reappropriated for FY2023-24 and for FY2024-25.</u>
- 20 Sec. 3. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$1,000,000 Federal Funds
- 21 for FY2021-22 and (2) \$249,000,000 Federal Funds for FY2022-23 to the
- 22 Department of Economic Development, for Program 611, to aid in carrying
- 23 out the provisions of Legislative Bill 1024, One Hundred Seventh
- 24 Legislature, Second Session, 2022. The Federal Funds appropriated in this
- 25 section are from the funds allocated to the State of Nebraska from the
- 26 federal Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant to the federal
- 27 American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, 42 U.S.C. 802, as amended.
- 28 <u>Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per</u>
- 29 diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$200,000
- 30 <u>for FY2021-22 or \$1,200,000 for FY2022-23.</u>

- 18 <u>Seventh Legislature, Second Session, 2022. The Federal Funds appropriated</u>
- 19 <u>in this section are from the funds allocated to the State of Nebraska</u>
- 20 <u>from the United States Economic Development Administration's American</u>
- 21 Rescue Plan Travel, Tourism and Outdoor Recreation program.
