- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the State Department of Education; to
- 2 provide for an aid program; and to declare intent to appropriate
- 3 funds.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. (1) The State Department of Education shall create a

- 2 program to provide aid to:
- 3 (a) Employees or self-employed individuals who provide child care or
- 4 education programs for children; and
- 5 (b) Providers of activities that support early childhood workforce
- 6 recruitment and retention.
- 7 (2) For purposes of this section:
- 8 (a) Early childhood care and education program means any of the
- 9 <u>following:</u>
- 10 (i) A child care program licensed under the Child Care Licensing Act
- 11 which serves children from birth to kindergarten;
- 12 <u>(ii) A prekindergarten service or program established pursuant to</u>
- 13 <u>section 79-1104;</u>
- 14 (iii) A Head Start program pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 9831 et seq., as
- 15 such sections existed on January 1, 2022; or
- 16 (iv) An Early Head Start program pursuant to 42 U.S.C. 9840a et
- 17 seg., as such sections existed on January 1, 2022; and
- 18 (b) Early childhood workforce means employees of or a self-employed
- 19 <u>individual at an early childhood care and education program based in</u>
- 20 <u>Nebraska.</u>
- 21 (3) It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate fifteen
- 22 million dollars from the General Fund each fiscal year to the State
- 23 <u>Department of Education for the purpose of carrying out this section.</u>
