LB950 2022

- 1 Section 1. (1) The Legislature hereby finds and declares that:
- 2 (a) The COVID-19 public health emergency fundamentally changed how
- 3 the University of Nebraska operates and highlighted the need to support
- 4 students and future workers emerge from the COVID-19 public health
- 5 emergency with the education and skills required to fill occupations that
- 6 are in high demand; and
- 7 <u>(b) It is the policy of this state to respond to harmful economic</u>
- 8 disruptions resulting from the COVID-19 public health emergency by
- 9 promoting job skills training and developing the workforce infrastructure
- 10 by increasing (i) opportunities for academic programs across Nebraska,
- 11 <u>(ii)</u> research infrastructure and capacity for University of Nebraska
- 12 <u>students and faculty, and (iii) employment opportunities for high-skilled</u>
- 13 graduates and researchers in Nebraska.
- 14 (2) There is hereby appropriated \$10,000,000 from Federal Funds for
- 15 FY2022-23 to the University of Nebraska for the intended purpose of
- 16 academic medical research and development at the Global Center for Health
- 17 Security at the University of Nebraska Medical Center. The Federal Funds
- 18 appropriated in this section are from the funds allocated to the State of
- 19 Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant
- 20 to the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Public Law 117-2,
- 21 Subtitle M, Sec. 9901.
- 22 Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 23 passed and approved according to law.
