The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

Legislative Bill 1093 provides that villages located within five miles of a state park may apply for state assistance in the form of state sales tax revenue, receiving no more than fifty percent of the final cost of the project upon approval. All applications are subject to approval by the Nebraska Department of Economic Development.

The department may approve applications for assistance after a required public hearing and deeming the enhancement project being in the best interest of the state. The department shall not accept applications for state assistance after June 30, 2023.
