

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 386

Approved by the Governor April 26, 2021

Introduced by Lathrop, 12; at the request of the Governor.

A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to judges' salaries; to amend section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020; to change judges' salaries; to provide an operative date; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020, is amended to read:

~~24-201.01 On January 1, 2019, the salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred seventy-six thousand two hundred ninety-nine dollars and thirty-eight cents. On July 1, 2019, the salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred eighty-one thousand five hundred eighty-eight dollars and thirty-six cents. On July 1, 2020, the salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred eighty-seven thousand thirty-six dollars and one cent. On July 1, 2021, the salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred ninety-two thousand six hundred forty-seven dollars and nine cents. On July 1, 2022, the salary of the Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall be one hundred ninety-eight thousand four hundred twenty-six dollars and fifty-one cents.~~

The Chief Justice and the judges of the Supreme Court shall hold no other public office of profit or trust during their terms of office nor accept any public appointment or employment under the authority of the government of the United States for which they receive compensation for their services. Such salaries shall be payable in equal monthly installments.

Sec. 2. This act becomes operative on July 1, 2021.

Sec. 3. Original section 24-201.01, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020, is repealed.

Sec. 4. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
