Dear Governor Pillen and Mr. Metzler,

Please accept this report of the Nebraska Department of Insurance for the period ending December 31, 2023, to fulfill the reporting requirements of <u>Neb. Rev. Stat.</u> § 4-113. The statute requires the agency to report to the Governor and the Clerk of the Legislature compliance with <u>Neb. Rev. Stat.</u> § 4-108 to 4-113 and to include the "total number of applicants for benefits and the number of applicants rejected pursuant to such sections." As defined by these sections of law, the Department of Insurance provides the following state benefits: employment, employment benefits, contracts with individuals, and licensing of individuals.

The total number of applicants for state benefits: 16,685.

The total number performed via the Systematic Alien Verification for Entitlements (SAVE) program: 624. The total number of individuals rejected due to the restrictions of Neb. Rev. Stat. § 4-108 to 4-113: 13.

The Department of Insurance has also taken the following actions to ensure compliance with Neb. Rev. Stat. § 4-108 to 4-113 during 2023:

- 1. E-Verify Program Participant.
- 2. Utilization of the Department of Administrative Services attestation forms.
- Contract requirements for all contracts and sub-contracts.
