Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would modify the required timeline for ballot question committees filing campaign statements under the Nebraska Political Accountability and Disclosure Act (NPADA). Current law requires that the first statement be filed no later than the last day of the calendar month when the committee filed the petition form with the Secretary of State, and additional statements to be filed on the last day of each subsequent calendar month, with a closing date five days before the statement filing deadline. This bill would move the filing deadline for first and subsequent campaign statements to ten days after the end of each calendar month, with the closing date set as the last day of the month.

This bill contains the emergency clause.
