Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill proposes changes to statutes pertaining to duties of the Attorney General.

Section 1 of the bill eliminates references to two sections of statute, one of which is repealed outright by Section 3.

Section 2 contains the partial repealer.

Section 3 outright repeals a section of statute providing duties to the Attorney General relating to agency implementation of legislative acts.
