Sec 1: Include the appropriate section of this bill under the Medical Assistance Act

Sec 2: Beginning July 1, 2024 DHHS shall establish a pharmacy dispensing fee of \$10.38 per

Rx until an actual cost can be established through a Dispensing Survey. DHHS shall amend all Medicaid contracts to adhere to this section. On or before 12/15/24 DHHS shall submit a report to the Clerk providing recommendations for adjusting the pharmacy dispensing fee.
