Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 261 changes the requirements of completing a split apprenticeship by allowing the apprentice license to be completed while attending a school of mortuary science.

Sec. 1: A split apprentice shall be completed by application for an apprentice license to complete a 6 month apprenticeship prior to or while attending an accredited school of mortuary science.

Current requirements involving course of study, examination, and completion of apprenticeship remain unchanged.
