Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 372 would allow for part-time enrollment of students who are residents of the school district.
School boards may allow part-time enrollment of students who are not residents of the school district.
Students who are residents of the school district, but not enrolled in the public school, to participate in extracurricular activities in accordance with the standards set forth in this bill.

Explanation of amendments:

Amendment 1231 directs school boards in their policy for extracurricular participation by part-time students to require a student to enroll in not more and no less than five credit hours offered by the school in any semester.
