## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill revises the Administrative Procedures Act. It includes legislative findings that burdens on charitable grantmaking should be free from "intrusive or politically motivated regulation." The bill defines "agency" broadly to include nearly all state executive branch agencies, the courts, and the Legislature.

Such agencies would be broadly prohibited from imposing additional filing or reporting requirements on charitable organizations beyond those required by state law. Agencies could impose such filing or reporting requirements if they can show a compelling state interest and a narrowly tailored means for serving that interest.
