Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 451 requires the Department of Health and Human Services to award a one-time grant to assist a rehabilitation hospital that has a distinct nursing facility part, that is located in Nebraska, and that has a capacity to provide post-acute long-term care to Medicaid patients. The grant shall include \$30 million for infrastructure and facilities upgrades. The grant shall not be expended no later than December 31, 2026. An emergency clause is also provided.
