Sec 1: No later than January 1, 2024, the department shall provide coverage for all necessary translation and interpretation services for eligible recipients utilizing a medical assistance program service. The department shall take all actions necessary to maximize federal funding to carry out this subsection.

Sec 2: Repealer
