Summary of purpose and/or changes:

The bill would amend Neb. Rev. Stat. 84-602, a statute that provides for the duties of the Nebraska Statute Treasurer. The bill would provide, section by section, as follows:

Section 1 amends statute 84-602 to add a requirement that the State Treasurer must ensure that the money deposited by the office of the State Treasurer into financial institutions not be used by those financial institutions for social or political causes or objectives.

Section 2 repeals the original section.
