Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This Nebraska Worker Training and Support Cash Fund provides training opportunities that expand the Nebraska workforce by increasing the pool of highly skilled workers in Nebraska, support public and private job training programs designed to train, retrain, or upgrade work skills of existing Nebraska workers of for-profit and not-for-profit businesses, recruit workers to Nebraska, and train new employees of expanding Nebraska businesses.

LB671 expands the allowable uses of funds available in the Nebraska Worker Training and Support Cash Fund to be granted to employers for the retention of existing workers.
