Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB769, introduced by Senator Holdcroft, amends Section 61-224, which created the Critical Infrastructure Facilities Cash Fund. LB769 makes available funds able to be used "to develop a sewer system" in addition to the current uses. LB769 also amends Section 84-612, and directs a transfer of sixty million dollars (\$60M) from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Critical Infrastructure Facilities Fund.
