## Summary:

This bill would direct the Department of Veterans' Affairs ("the Department") to provide grants relating to the United States Defense POW/MIA Accounting Agency ("the Agency") for undergraduate and graduate internships and academic programming to assist the Agency with its mission. A prerequisite for any such grant would be that the receiving institution has previously been designated as "Veteran and Active Duty Supportive" under existing state law. The bill also states the intent of the Legislature to appropriate \$200,000 from the General Fund to the Department for such grants.
