## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 805 would require schools to allow youth organizations to provide information, services, and activities in schools.

SECTION 1 Allows for youth organizations listed in 36 U.S.C. Subtitle II, part B to provide information about said organization to students. Persons providing the information must provide information to the school in advance and be subject to a background check.

SECTION 2 Exempts persons qualifying in section 1 of this act from current solicitation laws.
