Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB894 would amend 23-1701.01 to require a candidate for the office of sheriff to possess a law enforcement officer certificate. Once elected, a sheriff would be required to attend a Sheriff's Certification Course and obtain a certificate of completion.

Explanation of amendments:

AM2370 would replace the original bill. The new Section 1 would amend section 23-1701 to provide that a county sheriff appointed by a county board must also possess a law enforcement officer certificate.
