1 Section 1. Section 30-4115, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 30-4115 (1)(a) The office shall maintain the appropriate personnel 3
- and workload scope necessary to fulfill all its responsibilities and 4
- duties under the Public Guardianship Act. 5
- (b) The office shall provide appropriate and high-quality care and 6
- 7 support, including timely decisionmaking, to all public wards and public
- protected persons served by the Public Guardian and his or her designees. 8
- 9 (c) Public quardianship and public conservatorship cases shall be
- managed by the Public Guardian and be served by the multidisciplinary 10
- team through a caseload distribution of wards and protected persons that 11
- takes into consideration the: 12
- 13 (i) Identified needs of the service population;
- (ii) Complexity and status of each case, based upon factors such as 14
- individual's living situation, the type of guardianship being 15
- provided, or the existence of complex medical conditions; 16
- 17 (iii) Size of the geographical area covered;
- (iv) Qualifications and professional expertise of each team member; 18
- (v) Availability of auxiliary services by support staff and 19
- volunteers; 20
- (vi) Organizational responsibilities; and 21
- (vii) Applicable legal requirements. 22
- (2) The Public Guardian may accept an appointment as a public 23
- 24 guardian or public conservator for an individual not to exceed an average
- ratio of twenty-two twenty public wards or public protected persons to 25
- each member of the multidisciplinary team. When determining such average 26
- ratio, all full-time members of the office's multidisciplinary team may 27
- 28 be counted.
- (3) When the average ratio described in subsection (2) of this 29
- section has been reached, the Public Guardian shall not accept further 30
- appointments. The Public Guardian, upon reaching the maximum number of 31
