## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 319**

Introduced by Bostar, 29. Read first time January 11, 2023 Committee: Appropriations

- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to child care funding; to amend section
   84-612, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2022; to create
   funds; to provide duties for the State Department of Education and
   the Department of Health and Human Services; to provide for
   transfers from the Cash Reserve Fund; to repeal the original
   section; and to declare an emergency.
- 7 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. There is hereby created the Child Care Wages Fund to be 2 administered by the State Department of Education. The fund shall be used 3 to contract with a statewide organization in accordance with section 2 of 4 this act for the purpose of state aid. It is the intent of the 5 Legislature that a one-time transfer of ten million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund be used to establish the Child Care Wages Fund. Any money in 6 7 the Child Care Wages Fund available for investment shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion 8 9 Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.

10 Sec. 2. The State Department of Education shall establish procedures and criteria for purposes of distributions from the Child Care 11 Wages Fund to the Child Care WAGE\$ Nebraska program to be used for 12 13 providing salary supplements to child care and early education providers working with children five years of age or less in child care programs 14 15 licensed pursuant to sections 71-1908 to 71-1923. It is the intent of the Legislature that the supplements are expended by June 30, 2027. 16

17 Sec. 3. There is hereby created the Child Care Capacity Expansion Fund to be administered by the Department of Health and Human Services. 18 19 The department shall contract with a statewide nonprofit organization in accordance with section 4 of this act for the purpose of state aid. It is 20 21 the intent of the Legislature that a one-time transfer of forty million 22 dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund be used to establish the Child Care Capacity Expansion Fund. Any money in the Child Care Capacity Expansion 23 24 Fund available for investment shall be invested by the state investment 25 officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act. 26

27 Sec. 4. <u>The Department of Health and Human Services shall establish</u> 28 <u>procedures and criteria for purposes of providing grants to increase</u> 29 <u>child care capacity in areas of need from the Child Care Capacity</u> 30 <u>Expansion Fund to community organizations, entities, and child care</u> 31 providers licensed pursuant to sections 71-1908 to 71-1923 to start or expand child care programs for children from birth through five years of
 age. It is the intent of the Legislature that the grants be expended by
 June 30, 2027.

Sec. 5. Section 84-612, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
2022, is amended to read:

6 84-612 (1) There is hereby created within the state treasury a fund 7 known as the Cash Reserve Fund which shall be under the direction of the 8 State Treasurer. The fund shall only be used pursuant to this section.

9 (2) The State Treasurer shall transfer funds from the Cash Reserve 10 Fund to the General Fund upon certification by the Director of 11 Administrative Services that the current cash balance in the General Fund 12 is inadequate to meet current obligations. Such certification shall 13 include the dollar amount to be transferred. Any transfers made pursuant 14 to this subsection shall be reversed upon notification by the Director of 15 Administrative Services that sufficient funds are available.

16 (3) In addition to receiving transfers from other funds, the Cash
17 Reserve Fund shall receive federal funds received by the State of
18 Nebraska for undesignated general government purposes, federal revenue
19 sharing, or general fiscal relief of the state.

(4) The State Treasurer shall transfer fifty-four million seven
hundred thousand dollars on or after July 1, 2019, but before June 15,
2021, from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Nebraska Capital Construction
Fund on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the budget
administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative
Services.

(5) The State Treasurer shall transfer two hundred fifteen million five hundred eighty thousand dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Nebraska Capital Construction Fund on or after July 1, 2022, but before June 15, 2023, on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services.

1 (6) The State Treasurer shall transfer fifty-three million five 2 hundred thousand dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Perkins County 3 Canal Project Fund on or before June 30, 2023, on such dates and in such 4 amounts as directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of 5 the Department of Administrative Services.

6 (7) No funds shall be transferred from the Cash Reserve Fund to 7 fulfill the obligations created under the Nebraska Property Tax Incentive 8 Act unless the balance in the Cash Reserve Fund after such transfer will 9 be at least equal to five hundred million dollars.

10 (8) The State Treasurer shall transfer thirty million dollars from 11 the Cash Reserve Fund to the Military Base Development and Support Fund 12 on or before June 30, 2023, but not before July 1, 2022, on such dates 13 and in such amounts as directed by the budget administrator of the budget 14 division of the Department of Administrative Services.

(9) The State Treasurer shall transfer eight million three hundred thousand dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Trail Development and Maintenance Fund on or after July 1, 2022, but before July 30, 2022, on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services.

(10) The State Treasurer shall transfer fifty million dollars from
the Cash Reserve Fund to the Nebraska Rural Projects Fund on or after
July 1, 2022, but before July 15, 2023, on such dates and in such amounts
as directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the
Department of Administrative Services.

(11) The State Treasurer shall transfer thirty million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Rural Workforce Housing Investment Fund on or after July 1, 2022, but before July 15, 2023, on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services.

30 (12) The State Treasurer shall transfer twenty million dollars from
 31 the Cash Reserve Fund to the Intern Nebraska Cash Fund on or after July

1, 2022, but before June 15, 2023, on such dates and in such amounts as
 directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the
 Department of Administrative Services.

4 (13) The State Treasurer shall transfer twenty million dollars from 5 the Cash Reserve Fund to the Middle Income Workforce Housing Investment 6 Fund on July 15, 2022, or as soon thereafter as administratively 7 possible, and in such amounts as directed by the budget administrator of 8 the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services.

9 (14) The State Treasurer shall transfer eighty million dollars from 10 the Cash Reserve Fund to the Jobs and Economic Development Initiative 11 Fund on or after July 1, 2022, but before July 15, 2023, on such dates 12 and in such amounts as directed by the budget administrator of the budget 13 division of the Department of Administrative Services.

(15) The State Treasurer shall transfer twenty million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Site and Building Development Fund on July 15, 2022, or as soon thereafter as administratively possible, and in such amounts as directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services.

(16) The State Treasurer shall transfer fifty million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Surface Water Irrigation Infrastructure Fund on or after July 15, 2022, but before January 1, 2023, on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services.

(17) The State Treasurer shall transfer fifteen million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Site and Building Development Fund on or before June 30, 2022, on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services.

(18) The State Treasurer shall transfer fifty-five million dollars
from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Economic Recovery Contingency Fund on
or before June 30, 2022, on such dates and in such amounts as directed by

the budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of
 Administrative Services.

3 (19) The State Treasurer shall transfer fifty million dollars from
4 the Cash Reserve Fund to the Early Childhood Education Endowment Cash
5 Fund on or after July 1, 2023, but before June 15, 2024, on such dates
6 and in such amounts as directed by the budget administrator of the budget
7 division of the Department of Administrative Services.

8 (20) The State Treasurer shall transfer ten million dollars from the 9 Cash Reserve Fund to the Child Care Wages Fund on July 1, 2023, or as 10 soon thereafter as administratively possible, on such date as directed by 11 the budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of 12 Administrative Services.

13 (21) The State Treasurer shall transfer forty million dollars from
 14 the Cash Reserve Fund to the Child Care Capacity Expansion Fund on July
 15 1, 2023, or as soon thereafter as administratively possible, on such date
 16 as directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the
 17 Department of Administrative Services.

18 Sec. 6. Original section 84-612, Revised Statutes Cumulative 19 Supplement, 2022, is repealed.

20 Sec. 7. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when 21 passed and approved according to law.
