- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as the Nebraska

- 2 <u>Teacher Recruitment and Retention Act.</u>
- 3 Sec. 2. <u>The purpose of the Nebraska Teacher Recruitment and</u>
- 4 Retention Act is to provide financial incentives to recruit and retain
- 5 teachers in Nebraska classrooms.
- 6 Sec. 3. For purposes of the Nebraska Teacher Recruitment and
- 7 Retention Act:
- 8 (1) Department means the State Department of Education;
- 9 (2) Grant means a grant for teacher recruitment and retention
- 10 payments under the Nebraska Teacher Recruitment and Retention Act; and
- 11 (3) Teacher means a person who holds a valid certificate to teach in
- 12 Nebraska issued by the Commissioner of Education and is employed in
- 13 Nebraska for the instruction of students in elementary or high school
- 14 grades.
- 15 Sec. 4. (1) Individual teachers may apply to the department for a
- 16 grant. The department shall not prioritize a grant based upon the school
- 17 where the applicant teaches.
- 18 (2) A teacher is eligible to apply for:
- 19 <u>(a) A recruitment grant if the teacher has completed such teacher's</u>
- 20 <u>first complete school year of full-time employment as a teacher at a</u>
- 21 Nebraska school in school years 2023-24, 2024-25, 2025-26, or 2026-27;
- 22 (b) A retention two grant if the teacher has completed such
- 23 teacher's second complete school year of full-time employment as a
- 24 teacher at a Nebraska school in school years 2023-24, 2024-25, 2025-26,
- 25 or 2026-27.
- 26 <u>(c) A retention three grant if the teacher has completed such</u>
- 27 <u>teacher's third complete school year of full-time employment as a teacher</u>
- 28 <u>at a Nebraska school in school years 2023-24, 2024-25, 2025-26, or</u>
- 29 <u>2026-27.</u>
- 30 (d) A high-need retention grant if a teacher completes a
- 31 certification in special education, mathematics, science, technology, or

- 1 dual credit and completes a school year of full-time employment as a
- 2 <u>teacher at a Nebraska school in school years 2024-25, 2025-26, or</u>
- 3 2026-27.
- 4 Sec. 5. It is the intent of the Legislature to encourage individual
- 5 schools and school districts to adopt policies incentivizing teacher
- 6 recruitment and retention through policies similar to the Nebraska
- 7 Teacher Recruitment and Retention Act. Teachers at schools not adopting a
- 8 recruitment and retention policy shall not be prohibited from receiving a
- 9 grant under the Nebraska Teacher Recruitment and Retention Act.
- 10 Sec. 6. It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate ten
- 11 <u>million dollars from the General Fund to the Nebraska Teacher Recruitment</u>
- 12 and Retention Act. Each grant shall be five thousand dollars.
- Sec. 7. The State Board of Education may adopt and promulgate rules
- 14 and regulations to carry out the Nebraska Teacher Recruitment and
- 15 Retention Act.
- 16 Sec. 8. The Nebraska Teacher Recruitment and Retention Act
- 17 terminates on January 1, 2028.
