1 Section 1. Section 38-2037, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 38-2037 (1) In addition to the grounds for disciplinary action
- 4 found in sections 38-178 and 38-179, a license to practice medicine and
- 5 surgery or osteopathic medicine and surgery or a license to practice as a
- 6 physician assistant may be denied, refused renewal, limited, revoked, or
- 7 suspended or have other disciplinary measures taken against it in
- 8 accordance with section 38-196 when the applicant or licensee fails to
- 9 comply with the provisions of section 71-603.01, 71-604, 71-605, or
- 10 71-606 relating to the signing of birth and death certificates.
- 11 (2) A license to practice medicine and surgery or osteopathic
- 12 <u>medicine and surgery shall not be subject to any disciplinary measures as</u>
- 13 a result of the applicant or licensee expressing an opinion or providing
- 14 medical advice that disagrees with the medical consensus on an issue of
- 15 health or disease unless the opinion or advice is disseminated with
- 16 malicious intent or an intent to deceive.
