**LEGISLATIVE RESOLUTION 161**

Introduced by McDonnell, 5; Bostar, 29.

PURPOSE: The purpose of this resolution is to propose an interim study to examine the Nebraska State Patrol Retirement System and the changes to the Nebraska State Patrol Retirement System proposed in Legislative Bill 196 introduced in the One Hundred Eighth Legislature of Nebraska, First Session. The study shall examine issues related to the retirement system including, but not limited to, funding needs, benefits, contributions, and administration and any actuarial or cost studies prepared and presented in conjunction with Legislative Bill 196.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE ONE HUNDRED EIGHTH LEGISLATURE OF NEBRASKA, FIRST SESSION:

1. That the Nebraska Retirement Systems Committee of the Legislature shall be designated to conduct an interim study to carry out the purposes of this resolution.

2. That the committee shall upon the conclusion of its study make a report of its findings, together with its recommendations, to the Legislative Council or Legislature.
