- 3 Section 1. At the general election in November 2024, the following
- 4 proposed amendment to the Constitution of Nebraska shall be submitted to
- 5 the electors of the State of Nebraska for approval or rejection:
- 6 To add a new section 31 to Article I:
- 7 <u>I-31</u> The right of individual privacy is essential to the well-being
- 8 of a free society and shall not be infringed without the showing of a
- 9 <u>compelling state interest.</u>
- 10 Sec. 2. The proposed amendment shall be submitted to the electors
- 11 in the manner prescribed by the Constitution of Nebraska, Article XVI,
- 12 section 1, with the following ballot language:
- 13 A constitutional amendment to prohibit infringement of the right of
- 14 individual privacy without a compelling state interest.
