Introducer's Statement of Intent

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB1313 allows non-profit agricultural membership organizations, or an affiliate, to offer a non-insurance, high-quality, and affordable health benefit plan to its members. The health benefits are provided under a self-funded arrangement administered by a third-party administrator. Non-profit agricultural membership organizations would have to certify with the Department of Insurance that the organization meets the requirements needed to be a sponsoring entity.

Because the health benefit plan is defined as "not insurance," LB1313 allows the creation of individual non-ACA-compliant member health care benefit coverage that would be fully underwritten and individually rated. This allows agricultural organizations to offer coverage to their members for a significantly lower cost. Agricultural organizations, through a third-party administrator, would be able to offer coverage that would include office visits, hospitalization, preventive care, emergency room services, maternity care, prescription drug benefits, mental health, and substance abuse.
