The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB628 modifies the definition of professional services in the Limited Liability statutes to mirror the definition of the professional corporation statutes. There is a grandfather clause so the Limited Liability Corporations that don't want to make a change are not required to do so.

There are a few other changes to the statutes related to professional services.

- 1. Clean-up of the use of ancillary services in the Limited Liability Corporation professional entity statutes.
- 2. Recognize outside certifying organizations or compacts recognized by the regulatory body. (This is applicable to some health professionals)
- 3. Requires regulatory bodies that use the electronic access process for verifying licensure to work with the Nebraska Secretary of State's office to create an automated process for us to electronically access and verify licensing records.
- 4. Strikes the requirement for the professional to list their residence address in a filing with the Nebraska Secretary of States Office.
