

LEGISLATIVE BILL 20

Approved by the Governor January 29, 1971

Introduced by C. W. Holmquist, 16th District

AN ACT to amend section 60-430, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to motor vehicles; to correct internal references; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 60-430, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

60-430. Whoever violates the provisions of sections 60-401 to 60-430 shall upon conviction be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, unless the act committed is by law declared to be a felony, and every person convicted of such misdemeanor shall be fined not exceeding one hundred dollars, or be imprisoned in the county jail not exceeding three months, or be both so fined and imprisoned, except that any person convicted of operating a motor vehicle in violation of any order of suspension or revocation of his license or privilege to operate a motor vehicle by either any court or the Director of Motor Vehicles, or after such suspension or revocation and before reinstatement of the license or issuance of a new one, shall be punished as provided in sections 60-430.01 and ~~60-430.02~~ 60-430.07.

Sec. 2. That original section 60-430, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
