

LEGISLATIVE BILL 477

Approved by the Governor March 9, 1971

Introduced by C. W. Holmquist, 16th District

AN ACT relating to the Nebraska State Patrol; to provide for a criminalistics laboratory within the Nebraska State Patrol; and to provide the uses for such a laboratory as prescribed.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. A criminalistics laboratory is hereby established within the Nebraska State Patrol, under the direction of the superintendent of law enforcement and public safety. The laboratory shall perform services necessary for the recognition and proper preservation, identification and scientific analysis of evidence materials pertaining to the investigation of crimes.
