

LEGISLATIVE BILL 750

Approved by the Governor April 28, 1971

Introduced by Terry Carpenter, 48th District; Wally Barnett, Jr., 26th District

AN ACT relating to volunteer firemen; to require life insurance as prescribed for all volunteer firemen.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. The governing body of any incorporated municipality having a volunteer fire department and the board of directors of each rural or suburban fire protection district shall purchase and maintain in force a policy of group term life insurance to age sixty-five covering the lives of all of its volunteer firemen. Such policy shall provide a minimum death benefit of two thousand dollars for death from any cause and shall, at the option of the individual fireman, be convertible to a permanent form of life insurance at age sixty-five. The coverage of such policy shall terminate as to any individual who ceases to be an active volunteer fireman of the municipality or district.
