## LEGISLATIVE BILL 277

Approved by the Governor April 11, 1973

Introduced by C. Carsten, 2

AN ACT to amend section 23-113, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to counties; to provide for the care and maintenance of abandoned cemeteries and Indian burial grounds as prescribed; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 23-113, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

23-113. When--petitioned---by---twenty-five freeholders-of-the--county--the The county board may expend money from the general fund of the county for the care and maintenance of each abandoned and neglected cemetery and Indian burial ground as follows: (1) Not to exceed two hundred fifty dollars in any one year when the cemetery is totally abandoned; or (2) not to exceed two hundred dollars in any one year when the cemetery is partially abandoned. Such care and maintenance shall consist of the repair or building of fences and annual spraying for the control of weeds and brush.

Sec. 2. That original section 23-113, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
