AN ACT to amend section 2-1203, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to the State Racing Commission; to provide that certain duties may be delegated to a board of stewards; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 2-1203, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

2-1203. The commission shall have power to prescribe and enforce rules and regulations governing horse races and race meetings, licensed as hereinafter provided. The commission may delegate to a board of stewards such of the commission's powers and duties as may be necessary to carry out and effectuate the purposes of sections 2-1201 to 2-1219. Any decision or action of such board of stewards may be appealed to the commission or reviewed by the commission on its own initiative.

Sec. 2. That original section 2-1203, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
