

LEGISLATIVE BILL 685

Approved by the Governor March 3, 1978

Introduced by Barnett, 26

AN ACT to amend section 71-4410, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to rabies; to harmonize with the Nebraska Criminal Code; to provide for seizure of animals as prescribed; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 71-4410, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

71-4410. The owner of any dog or any person who violates any of the provisions of sections 71-4401 to 71-4412 shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, ~~and shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not more than twenty dollars and not less than five dollars~~ Class V misdemeanor. When the owner of any dog or other animal fails or refuses to comply with the provisions of section 71-4406 or 71-4407, the rabies control authority shall obtain an order for seizure of such animal pursuant to Chapter 29, article 8.

Sec. 2. That original section 71-4410, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
