

LEGISLATIVE BILL 194

Approved by the Governor March 8, 1979

Introduced by Appropriations Committee, Warner, 25, Chmn.; Cope, 36; S. Marsh, 29; Rumery, 42; Fowler, 27; Hasebroock, 18; Dworak, 22

AN ACT to amend sections 77-2417 and 85-131, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, relating to appropriations; to remove exceptions from the provision that appropriations be of specific sums; to remove the appropriation of accrued university funds; to eliminate a requirement to file certain reports; and to repeal the original sections, and also section 85-111.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 77-2417, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

77-2417. All appropriations of money from the state treasury, whether such money be derived from the levy of state taxes or from any other source, shall be by the appropriation of specific sums. ~~Provided, that the provisions of this section shall not apply to the institutional cash funds of the various state institutions, nor to money received otherwise than by the levy of taxes by the state university, Nebraska State Colleges, and Department of Agriculture, nor to examination fees received by the various boards and officers connected with the Department of Health.~~

Sec. 2. That section 85-131, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

85-131. Disbursements from the university funds shall be made by the State Treasurer upon warrants drawn by the Director of Administrative Services, who shall issue warrants upon certificates issued by the Board of Regents, signed by the secretary and president. ~~All money accruing to the university funds is hereby appropriated to the use of the state university.~~

Sec. 3. That original sections 77-2417 and 85-131, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and also section 85-111.01, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, are repealed.
