

LEGISLATIVE BILL 188

Approved by the Governor May 14, 1981

Introduced by Judiciary Committee, Nichol, 48, Chpn.; Von Minden, 17; Chambers, 11; Chronister, 18; Beyer, 3

AN ACT to amend section 48-806, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1980, relating to labor; to increase the per diem for judges of the Commission of Industrial Relations; to repeal the original section; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 48-806, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1980, be amended to read as follows:

48-806. As soon as such compensation may be legally paid under the Constitution of the State of Nebraska, the compensation of judges of the Commission of Industrial Relations shall be one hundred ~~fifty~~ eighty dollars per day for each day's time actually engaged in the performance of the duties of their office. Each judge shall also be paid his or her necessary traveling expenses incurred while away from his or her place of residence upon business of the commission in accordance with sections 84-306.01 to 84-306.09.

Sec. 2. That original section 48-806, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1980, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
