

LEGISLATIVE BILL 74

Approved by the Governor April 16, 1981

Introduced by Constitutional Revision and Recreation Committee, Labedz, 5, Chpn.; Carsten, 2; Higgins, 9; H. Peterson, 35; Vickers, 38

AN ACT to amend section 37-1105, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1980, relating to park entry permits; to change permit fees; to provide an operative date; and to repeal the original section, and also section 37-1105.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1980.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 37-1105, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1980, be amended to read as follows:

37-1105. The commission shall devise permits in two forms: Annual and temporary.

(1) The annual permit may be purchased by any person and shall be valid through December 31 of the year for which issued. The fee for the annual permit shall be five dollars per permit.

(2) A temporary permit may be purchased by any person and shall be valid until noon of the day following the date of issue. The fee for the temporary permit shall be ~~one-dollar-and-fifty-cents~~ two dollars.

Sec. 2. This act shall become operative on January 1, 1982.

Sec. 3. That original section 37-1105, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1980, and also section 37-1105.01, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1980, are repealed.
