

LEGISLATIVE BILL 878

Approved by the Governor April 19, 1986

Introduced by Chambers, 11

AN ACT relating to social security numbers; to amend section 60-403, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to require social security numbers on applications for motor vehicle operator's licenses for use as prescribed; to eliminate a requirement that social security numbers be used on operator's licenses and other documents; and to repeal the original section, and also section 68-633, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 60-403, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

60-403. Except as herein otherwise provided, no resident of the State of Nebraska shall operate a motor vehicle upon the streets, alleys, or public highways of the State of Nebraska until the person has obtained a license for that purpose. Application for such an operator's license shall be made under oath or affirmation on uniform blanks prepared and furnished to the county treasurers, examiners of the Department of Motor Vehicles, and any local examiners by the Director of Motor Vehicles. The standard application blanks shall be sufficient in form and content to substantially carry out the purposes of this act. They shall contain, in addition to any other information and questions necessary to comply with the requirements and purposes of this act, the name, age, post office address, place of residence, date of birth, sex, social security number, except that such social security number shall not be printed on the operator's license and shall be used only with the permission of the director in connection with the verification of the status of an individual's driving record in this state or any other state, and a brief description of the applicant and the following specific questions: (1) Do you suffer from any physical defects that would detract from normal ability to safely operate a motor vehicle? (2) Have you suffered dismemberment of foot, leg, hand, or arm? (3) Are you subject to vertigo or fainting spells? (4) Has

your operator's license ever been revoked or suspended, and if so give date and period of each such occurrence.

Sec. 2. That original section 60-403, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and also section 68-633, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, are repealed.
