

LEGISLATIVE BILL 110

Approved by the Governor February 14, 1987

Introduced by Withem, 14

AN ACT relating to state employees; to amend section 81-1315, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to eliminate a prohibition on holding office in a political party; to provide for disciplinary action for certain violations; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 81-1315, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

81-1315. All state employees subject to the provisions of sections 81-1301 to 81-1317 shall be and hereby are prohibited from holding office in any political party. State employees subject to the provisions of sections 81-1301 to 81-1317 81-1316 shall be and hereby are prohibited from participation in political activities during office hours or while otherwise engaged in the performance of official duties as employees of this state. Any employee violating this section shall be subject to disciplinary action under the rules and regulations adopted and promulgated pursuant to sections 81-1301 to 81-1335. Such disciplinary action may include demotion, dismissal, reduction of salary, or suspension.

Sec. 2. That original section 81-1315, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
