

## LEGISLATIVE BILL 1067

Approved by the Governor March 12, 1990

AN ACT relating to state institutions; to amend section 83-186, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to eliminate the advisory committees for the Departments of Social Services, Public Institutions, and Correctional Services; to eliminate the Older Nebraskans Act; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original section, and also sections 68-702.01, 68-702.02, 68-702.03, 68-1301, 68-1302, 68-1303, 68-1304, 68-1305, 68-1306, 83-101.06, and 83-101.07, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 83-186, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

83-186. (1) The following persons shall be allowed to visit any facility in the Department of Correctional Services at any time:

- (a) Members of the Legislature;
- (b) Members of the judiciary;
- (c) Members of the Board of Pardons;
- (d) Members of the Board of Parole; and
- (e) Members of the advisory committee to the Department of Public Institutions and the Department of Correctional Services; and

~~(f)~~ (e) Members of the clergy, subject to the approval of the Director of Correctional Services.

(2) The chief executive officer of a facility may permit any other person to visit the facility.

Sec. 2. That original section 83-186, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, and also sections 68-702.01, 68-702.02, 68-702.03, 68-1301, 68-1302, 68-1303, 68-1304, 68-1305, 68-1306, 83-101.06, and 83-101.07, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, are repealed.
