

LEGISLATIVE BILL 443

Approved by the Governor March 14, 1989

AN ACT relating to criminal procedure; to eliminate the requirement of corroboration of testimony for certain offenses; to repeal section 29-2013, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; and to declare an emergency.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. The testimony of a person who is a victim of a sexual assault as defined in sections 28-319, 28-320, and 28-320.01 shall not require corroboration.

Sec. 2. That section 29-2013, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.

Sec. 3. Since an emergency exists, this act shall be in full force and take effect, from and after its passage and approval, according to law.
