

LEGISLATIVE BILL 831

Approved by the Governor March 12, 1990

Introduced by Labeledz, 5

AN ACT relating to the Land Reutilization Commission; to amend section 77-3203, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to change the number of members on such commission; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 77-3203, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

77-3203. (1) In each county described in section 77-3201, there is hereby created the Land Reutilization Commission, which shall be composed of ~~five~~ three members, one of whom shall be appointed by the governing body of the most populous city within the county, one of whom shall be appointed by the board of county commissioners, and one of whom shall be appointed by the board of education of the school district serving the most populous city of the county, and the county treasurer and county assessor shall be ex officio members. The appointed members shall serve at the pleasure of their the respective appointing authority and shall serve without compensation. The members so appointed may be employees of the appointing authority, and shall serve without additional compensation. No member shall receive compensation for serving on the commission.

(2) Any vacancy in the ~~appointive~~ office of commissioner shall be filled by the same appointing authority which made the original appointment.

Sec. 2. That original section 77-3203, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
