AN ACT relating to liquor; to amend section 53-184, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943; to authorize the refilling of original packages for private use; and to repeal the original section.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

That section 53-184, Reissue Section 1. Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, be amended to read as follows:

53-184. No person, except a manufacturer, distributor, or wholesaler, shall fill or refill, in whole or in part, any original package of alcoholic liquor with the same or any other kind or quality of alcoholic liquor. It ; and it shall be unlawful for any person to have in his or her possession for sale at retail any bottles, casks, or other containers containing alcoholic liquor, except in original packages. Nothing in this section shall prohibit the refilling of original packages of alcoholic liquor for strictly private use and not for resale. Sec. 2. That original section 53-184, Reissue

Revised Statutes of Nebraska, 1943, is repealed.
