

LEGISLATIVE BILL 15

Approved by the Governor August 14, 1992

Introduced by Schrock, 39; Elmer, 38

AN ACT relating to redistricting; to amend sections 50-1139 and 50-1145, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1991, and section 50-1152, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1991, as amended by Laws 1992, LB 946, section 1; to change provisions relating to legislative districts; to change operative date provisions; and to repeal the original sections.

Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. That section 50-1139, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1991, be amended to read as follows:

50-1139. District No. 38 shall contain the counties of Webster, Franklin, Harlan, and Furnas Gosper, and Phelps, that part of Red Willow Furnas County not included in legislative district 44, and that part of Nuckolls County not located in legislative district 32.

Sec. 2. That section 50-1145, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1991, be amended to read as follows:

50-1145. District No. 44 shall contain the counties of Perkins, Chase, Dundy, Hitchcock, Hayes, Frontier, and Red Willow and that part of Furnas County which includes the precincts of Cambridge and Wilsonville, Gosper, and Phelps and that part of Red Willow County which includes the precincts of Grant, Gerver, Briftweed, Valley Grange, Danbury, Beaver, Tyrene, Missouri Ridge, Bondville, Lebanon, Perry, Coleman, and Ben Eider.

Sec. 3. That section 50-1152, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1991, as amended by Laws 1992, LB 946, section 1, be amended to read as follows:

50-1152. Sections ~~50-1101 to 50-1152~~ 50-1101 to 50-1138, 50-1140 to 50-1144, and 50-1146 to 50-1151 shall become operative on April 16, 1992, except that members of the Legislature from the odd-numbered districts mentioned in such sections ~~50-1101 to 50-1152~~ shall be nominated at the primary election in 1992 and elected at the general election in November 1992 for the term commencing January 6, 1993. This act shall become

operative on the effective date of this act. The members of the Legislature elected or appointed prior to April 16, 1992 the effective date of this act, shall represent the newly established districts for the balance of their terms, with each member representing the same numbered district as prior to April 16, 1992 the effective date of this act.

Sec. 4. That original sections 50-1139 and 50-1145, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1991, and section 50-1152, Revised Statutes Supplement, 1991, as amended by Laws 1992, LB 946, section 1, are repealed.
